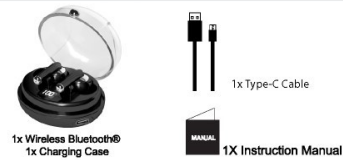
1. Introduction

Congratulations, and thank you for choosing Truebuds Chrome wireless stereo earbuds, By GabbaGoods. This manual help you operate the Truebuds Chrome wireless earbuds, but first you should familiarize yourself with the Bluetooth® functionality of your mobile phone or smart device before using the Truebuds wireless stereo earbuds.

4. How To Use	
4.1. General Functions	
Desired Result	Required Action
Auto Power On	Simply remove the TrueBuds from the charging cradle and they will automatically turn on
Syncing the TRUEBUDS Together	Once you remove both TrueBuds from the charging cradle they will pair each other automatically
Pairing	Use a Bluetooth® enabled mobile phone or other Bluetooth® enabled device to perform necessary pairing actions
Auto Turn Off	Simply place the TrueBuds back into the cradle and they will power off on their own; or press and hold the multi-function button for 5 seconds to turn the TrueBuds off. Each Truebud needs to be turned off individually
Answering a Call	Press the multi-function button on the TrueBud to answer phone calls, press the multi-function button again to end calls
Play / Pause Music	Pause a track by pressing the multi-function button; press it again to resume the track
Previous Track / Next Track	Tap and hold the Multi-Function button on the right earbud to skip to the next song, tap and hold the Multi-Function button on the left earbud to go to the previous song
Volume Control	Double tap the Multi-Function button on the right earbud to increase the volume. Double tap the Multi-Function button on the left earbud to lower the volume
Siri® / Google® Assistant	Triple tap the Multi-Function button to activate Siri® or Google® Assistant

4.2 Syncing

1. To use your Bluetooth® stereo Truebuds, you must first pair your Truebuds to a Bluetooth® enabled device. Once your Bluetooth® Truebuds are paired to a smart device, they will remain paired and automatically recognize each other whenever they are within range.

2. To switch on and sync the Truebuds together simply remove them from the charging case and they will turn on automatically, the Truebuds LED light will start to flash red and blue, and the other earbuds LED light will turn off, they are now ready to be paired with a Bluetooth® compatible device. Be sure that your devices Bluetooth® function is turned on.

3. Search for the Truebuds using a Bluetooth® compatible device. Select "Truebuds Chrome" from the list of devices to connect and pair. Once paired the Truebuds will prompt you "Your Bluetooth device is connected"

4. To unpair or remove a Bluetooth® compatible device from the Truebuds turn off the Bluetooth® function on the compatible device. The Truebuds can now be paired with a new compatible device.

5. Note: Pairing mode will last for 3-4 minutes. If no Bluetooth® devices are paired within this time, the Truebuds will automatically power-off.

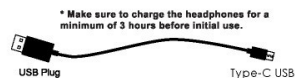
4.3 Charging your Stereo TRUEBUDS

The charging case is fitted with a 300 mAh rechargeable battery (non-removable). It's recommended that the battery is fully charged before the first use; this will take about 2 hours. Connect the Type-C USB end of the Cable included into the Type-C port on the charging case and the other end to a compatible USB wall charger or PC.

While charging the LCD screen will show the percentage of the battery. The second digit will start to flash and the percentage will start to increase. Once the charging case is fully charged the LCD screen will show 100%.

Carefully disconnect both ends of the USB charging cable and store it safely for future use. The Truebuds are each fitted with a 30 mAh rechargeable battery (non-removable). It's recommended that the battery is full charged before first use; this will take approx 1hr.

To Charge the Truebuds, carefully place each Truebud into its respective earbud slot. Once the Truebuds are placed in the charging case it will start to charge automatically. The LED light on the bottom of both earbuds will light up Blue, once they are fully charged the Blue LED light will turn off.



* Make sure to charge the headphones for a minimum of 3 hours before initial use.

6. FAQ

1. I only hear music out of 1 ear?
 Ans. To get your Truebuds working properly please follow the below steps.
 - Delete ("Forget") the Truebuds connection from your smart device and shut your smart device's Bluetooth off.
 - Power of the Truebuds completely and wait 10 seconds.
 - Place the Truebuds back into the charging case and wait 10 seconds. Then remove the Truebuds from the case and they will automatically power on and sync together. Once paired successfully you will hear the voice prompt say "Connected Successfully" and the right Truebuds LED light will flash red and blue and the left Truebuds LED light will turn off.

- Turn on the Bluetooth on your phone and search for "Truebuds Air" It should only come up once.
 - Connect to "Truebuds Air" and now your Truebuds should be paired to your phone and ready to use!

2. Why is there no power even when the Truebuds are Turned ON?
 ANS. Ensure the battery has been charged up to 2 hours for initial use.

3. There is no sound during playback?
 Ans. Check the connection between the Truebuds and your smart device if the connection is not established please connect again. Make sure the Truebuds are paired with your Bluetooth enabled device.

4. Can I use 1 Truebud at a time?
 Ans. Yes, if you would like to use only one Truebud at a time then simply turn on the side that you want to use and make sure the other Truebud is powered off, your music and phone calls will only play in mono sound.
